

## WHITE/BROWN GOODS PICKUP PROGRAM

The City of Wahpeton currently has a white/brown goods pickup program available. If you have a white/brown good that you need to recycle, but you have no way to take it to the Yard Waste area, stop at City Hall during normal office hours (8 am– 4 pm Monday–Friday) and purchase a sticker to put on your recyclable. This sticker will cost you between \$8.00—\$35.00 per item depending on the type. At that time we will determine a date and time the City can pick it up.

**White Goods**— Home appliances such as stoves, air conditioners, water heaters, dryers, deep freezers, microwaves, etc. (*Doors must be removed from all refrigerators and freezers*)

**Disposal fee for all items is \$12 each.**

### Electronic Waste—

Electronic waste (E-waste) are items such as televisions, computers, radios, stereo systems and space heaters.



### Fee for E-Waste disposal is:

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (HHM)

(Only accepted by appt. only.) You must make an appointment prior to HHM drop-off—there are no exceptions.

**LATEX PAINT**—is accepted for a fee of \$2.00 per can. Latex paint is not classified as a hazardous material BUT cannot be discarded with regular trash without first being dried out.

### EXAMPLES OF HHMs

**Automotive Products:** antifreeze, brake fluid, gasoline or diesel fuel, oil, transmission fluid, windshield wiper fluid.

**Home Improvement Products:** adhesives, paint, stain, varnish, paint thinner, wood preservatives (solvent-based products only).

**Cleaners:** floor wax/stripper, toilet bowl cleaner, furniture polish, metal cleaner, spot remover, window cleaner.

**Pesticides:** Flea collars, fungus-control chemicals, mothballs, insecticides, rat poison, weed and brush killers.

**Miscellaneous:** aerosol cans (not empty), hobby paints, button batteries, mercury thermometers, pool chemicals, kerosene.

# RECYCLING

Recycling is good for the environment because less trash goes into the landfill and all recycled items are then reused. Here in Wahpeton for your convenience we now have curbside recycling. All residents should have a 90 gallon gray container and commercial properties either have a 90 or 300 gallon container. Recycling will be on the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month. Please have your container out by 7 am.

Recycling is easy. Make sure all items put in the recycling container are clean. They can be co-mingled in your container. Items accepted include:

cardboard boxes, pop cartons, cereal and Kleenex boxes, plastics with the recycling code 1, 2, or 3, tin food containers, white paper such as typing or computer paper; newspapers of any type and books, magazines

and catalogs. Larger items such as boxes should be broken down so all items fit in the container with the lid closed.

The following **CAN NOT** be recycled: Glass, Styrofoam, bleach bottles, anti-freeze or oil containers, plastic grocery sacks (but remember you can take them back to the store that you got them from) window glass, light bulbs or ceramics.

In Wahpeton, Town & Country Disposal of Rock Rapids collects the recycling and all items are brought to Schaaps in Worthington, MN. Where it is sorted and processed.

# GARBAGE

Wahpeton's garbage is picked up by Town & Country Disposal of Rock Rapids and dumped at the Dickinson County Landfill east of Arnolds Park. The landfill has the last say in what can be put out as garbage and what carries an additional charge.

The City does not require special garbage bags but would like you to continue to use some type of bag when you put garbage in the large blue containers.

Garbage pickup days are Tuesdays & Saturdays, May through September and Tuesdays only October through April. Carts are owned by Town & Country and should remain with the property if sold. Carts damaged thru neglect by property owner will be replaced by resident. There is no limit on the number of bags you can use, however they should all fit into the new garbage carts with the lid closed. Larger items that do not fit should be broken down and placed in the container if at all possible. Extra cart fees of \$15.00/month could be imposed. The rule to follow for larger items is that it has to be able to be picked up by one person and that it will fit into the truck. Town & Country **DOES NOT PICKUP** white goods (appliances) or brown goods (electronics) for which there is a fee. Additionally, they do not pickup yard waste, construction materials or hazardous waste such as paints, batteries, pesticides, tires or oil & oil filters.

The City would like to encourage residents to put their garbage out the night before. Carts should be placed at the curbside with wheels toward your home. Carts need to be 3-5 feet from any other obstacle (trees, cars, mail boxes, poles, other carts). Your cart must be able to hold all of your garbage with the lid closed to prevent animals from ripping into the sacks and strewing trash everywhere which helps keep our beautiful community clean.

# YARD WASTE

Wahpeton is a member of the Dickinson County Landfill Commission and as such residents should use the Yard Waste Site located a mile east of the intersection of 13th Street and Highway 71 in Milford (go east at the light on the Catholic church corner) on the north side of County A34.

Nov.—March The site is open Mon., Wed. & Fridays 9 am-4pm.

April—Oct. Hours are Mon., Wed. & Fridays 9 am-4 pm. Tues. & Thur. from 11 am to 7 pm and no Saturdays. They



take trees and tree trimmings, brush, grass clippings, garden waste and leaves.

**No Contaminated Waste or Construction Debris**

### Disposal fees are:

Bagged -	50 cents per bag (\$1 minimum)
Small Trailer -1 axle	\$10.00
Pickup -	\$10.00
Single Axle Truck -	\$20.00
Double Axle Truck -	\$30.00
Roll Off -Garbage Truck	\$40.00

The Recycling Center has available, free of charge, wood chips and compost. Wood chips are beneficial for planting and care of trees & bushes by inhibiting weed growth and conserving moisture. Compost is beneficial to enhance soil fertility and lessen soil compaction.
