

RESOLUTION NO. 20-16

A RESOLUTION SETTING DOCK AND HOIST FEES FOR CITY-CONTROLLED ACCESS AREAS PURSUANT TO SECTION 139.03(1) OF THE WAHPETON CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, the Wahpeton City Council controls certain public access areas within the City of Wahpeton as listed in Section 139.02 of the Wahpeton City Code; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 103 of the Wahpeton City Code contains regulations governing the Public Lake Access Areas, providing for placement and use of docks and placement of watercraft hoists on the Public Lake Access Areas; and,

WHEREAS, Section 139.03(1) of the Wahpeton City Code provides that fees for docks and hoists placement “shall be reviewed annually by the City Council and set by resolution.”; and,

WHEREAS the City staff and a committee of the Council have reviewed and considered dock and hoist fees charged by the City of Wahpeton and by other providers of dock and hoist space on West Lake Okoboji and have recommended to the Wahpeton City Council an increase in dock and hoist fees; and,

WHEREAS, upon review and consideration, the Council has determined that the recommendations should be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Wahpeton City Council as follows:

Section 1. The following dock and hoist fees are hereby established for the city-controlled access areas pursuant to Section 139.03(1) of the Wahpeton City Code:

A. Docks on West Lake Okoboji

Dock Fee:	\$100.00
Per Hoist Rate payable on or before May 1, 2021:	\$300.00
Per Hoist Rate payable on or before May 1, 2022:	\$450.00
Per Hoist Rate payable on or before May 1, 2023:	\$650.00

B. Docks off West Lake Okoboji which require access under a bridge to West Lake Okoboji

Dock Fee:	\$100.00
Per Hoist Rate payable on or before May 1, 2021:	\$200.00
Per Hoist Rate payable on or before May 1, 2022:	\$350.00
Per Hoist Rate payable on or before May 1, 2023:	\$500.00

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any section, provision or part of this resolution shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. This resolution shall be in effect after its final passage and approval as provided by law.
